THE MEADOWS



The Meadows is a recognised and respected leader of specialist care of residents who live with long-term and progressive degenerative disorders, such as Huntington's Disease, Early Onset Dementia and all other forms of Dementia affecting adults of all ages.

THE ARBURY



The Arbury is a specialist care centre for residents requiring intensive or slow-stream post acute rehabilitation following acquired brain injury or spinal cord injury, but also supports long-term conditions including Cerebral Palsy and Multiple Sclerosis.

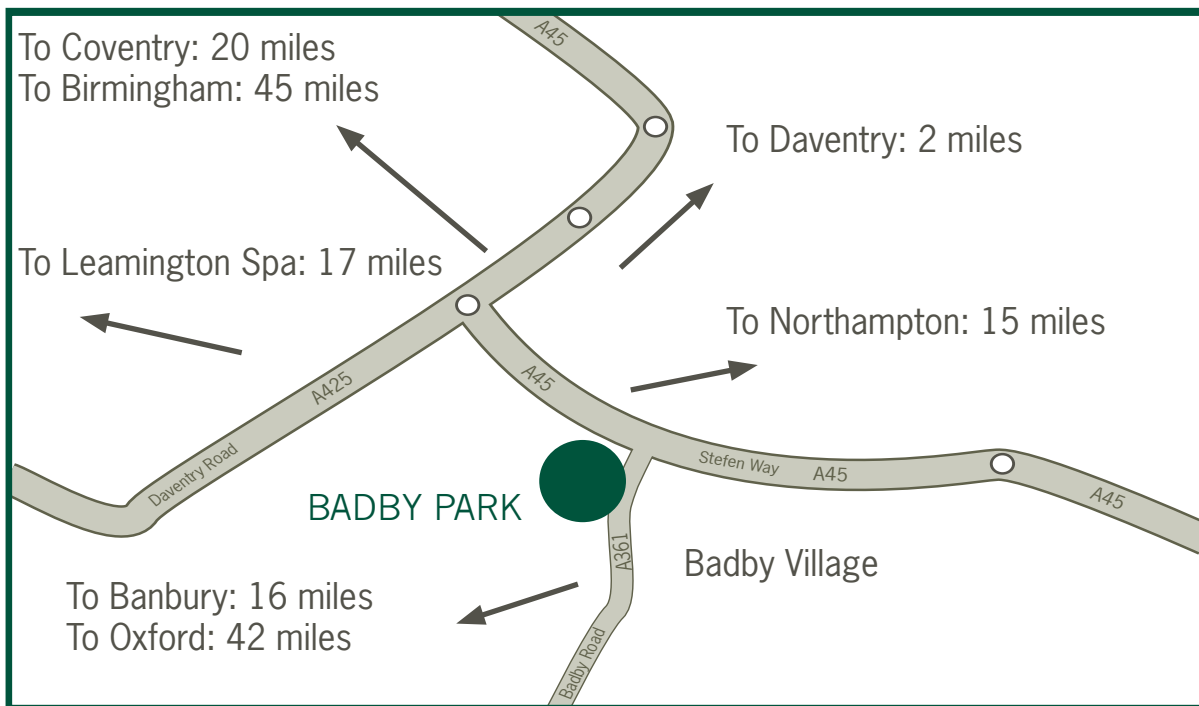
